Altitude difference: 470 m

Path duration: roundtrip 3 hours

Path sequence: CAI 172/173 – CAI 172 – summit signs

Supporting points: not present

Main interests: Landscape - Nature

Best time to go: all year round

From Carrara follow the signs for Campocecina (behind the hospital) to Foce di Pianza (between Mount Borla and Mount Sagro). Once you leave the car, take path 172/173: upon reaching a crossroads, continue to the right on path 172 which leads us briefly to the S side of a ridge and then to the N side, skirting the head of the quarry basin up to Pass of Foce della Faggiola (1464 m asl).

Here you leave the path 172 to head left following the blue signs that indicate the summit path for the Sagro: the path climbs on the S side of the mountain and comes out just before the summit on the W ridge; from here in a few minutes you can climb to the top of the mountain.
