Starting point: Resceto (485 m a.s.l.) **Arrival:** Monte Sella (1739 m a.s.l.)

Altitude difference: 1280 m

Path duration: to go 3 h; to come back 2 h 30'

Difficulty: EE (expert)

Path sequence: CAI 165 – CAI 160

Supporting points: Resceto **Main interests:** Landscape

Notes about the route: Physical preparation is required (given the steep difference

in height) and a lot of caution in the exposed sections

Best time to go: spring – summer - autumn

Accessibility: by car to Resceto

From Massa you have to continue towards Resceto (from where the famous Via Vandelli and numerous Vie di Lizza depart). After leaving the car, cross the town and, in the canal, take the CAI path 165. Take a stretch of Via di Lizza and along the way you will meet the Ponte Pisciarotto (696 m a.s.l.). At a crossroads (il 165 continues towards the Cave Cruze) take the CAI path 160 on the right and go up, still in a somewhat hostile landscape, towards the summit.

Mountain Safety:
